### International Student Expenses

Tuition Fee:	\$23,000.00 *

\* Tuition Fee includes but is not limited to tuition, textbooks, in-school tutors, yearly medical insurance, sports fees, some school club fees, yearbook, and a yearly trip to a major city in the United States with the other international students.

\*\* Housing Fee includes room and board, meals with the host family, daily hot lunch at the high school, and transportation to and from the airport.

## Special Services for International Students

**Individualized Instruction:** Manitowoc Lutheran has educators and student tutors to specifically offer one-on-one instruction, help, and guidance for our international students. Manitowoc Lutheran offers a premier university preparatory education with high academic standards. The educators and student tutors encourage the international students to do their best in order to achieve higher grades.

If international students are struggling with their course work, the students are required to use tutoring to improve their grades. Evaluations by Manitowoc Lutheran administration will be the deciding authority as to whether a student needs to continue or restart tutoring for specific course work.

**Student Mentoring Program:** At the first day of school, the international students will meet their student mentors. The student mentor is an American student who serves as a guide to the international student. During the first few weeks of school, the student mentor will help the international student become familiar with American high school culture. The mentor student will help with following school schedules, opening lockers, making American friends, and other various daily school life tasks. Student mentors are chosen by high school administration based on the American student's leadership abilities and willingness to serve.

**College Guidance:** College or university guidance begins at the 9<sup>th</sup> grade level at Manitowoc Lutheran and continues to graduation. International students are given one-on-one attention; making sure they are taking classes that are the best options for college acceptance. During the international students' 12<sup>th</sup> grade year, they receive assistance with college applications and transcript processing. Additionally, Manitowoc Lutheran offers TOEFL, ACT, and SAT prep courses. This all helps the international students get into the universities they want to attend.
