Tuition Assistance

The following is a summary only. Deadlines may differ slightly based on family situations.

Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP)

- State government voucher program. All criteria/requirements/deadlines are those of the Department of Public Instruction.
- Vouchers awarded by state via random selection from among all applicants to families that meet income limits (Adjusted Gross Income) on your tax return.
- Around February 1st, applications can be submitted online. This goes through DPI.
- MLHS strongly suggests using the DOR method to verify income. The DPI method can be used if you are close to the income limit. Please call with any questions.

Congregation Assistance

- Many congregations have tuition assistance programs of their own for their members attending MLHS. Each congregation administers their program a little differently to inquire early about the details and dates of their process.
- If you received a WPCP voucher, please notify your congregation.

MLHS Needs Based Tuition Assistance (NBTA)

- MLHS uses a program called TADS for the NBTA application.
- Applications require family information to be completed, a copy of your tax return, and other supporting documents to be included (so you will want to file your taxes as soon as possible)
- All applications are reviewed and evaluated by a Review Committee. Awards are determined based on need and available funds.

Tuition Vouchers

- The MLHS Academic Fair Vouchers are earned by participating in the MLHS Academic Fair which is held in the spring of each year. Each year of participation brings another opportunity to receive a voucher. Those vouchers are automatically applied to the TADS account of each incoming student during the first semester of their 9th grade year. The vouchers can be used for anything school related including tuition, hot lunch, etc.

SCRIP (www.mlhslancers.org/scrip)

- This is an excellent way to save for MLHS tuition/education credits, without spending an extra dime! By purchasing gift cards from MLHS to make everyday purchases (gas, groceries, clothing, restaurants, home improvements, medical expenses and much more), you generate a rebate from the many businesses that support the MLHS SCRIP program. A percentage of the rebate from the businesses is put into your TADS account for future tuition/education credits.
- If you have been/or may be selected into the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program, you can still purchase SCRIP and help pay for all the extra items that will be charged to your TADS account.
- If you haven't started using SCRIP yet, contact our SCRIP office today to open an account, and encourage grandparents, family members, etc. to use SCRIP!
- Mid-May – families will receive a form asking you to indicate how much of your scrip account balance you wish to redeem into your TADS account.
