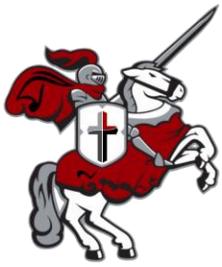

 7. Splitting Mixed Media and Sculpture into two separate classes.
 8. Splitting Drawing and Painting into two separate classes
