



Date of Meeting: Saturday, February 8, 2025

- The Maintenance department has developed a good relationship with Focus on Energy and to date has received almost \$3500 in rebates for LED lighting improvements. Those are continuing as well as an investigation of our heating system efficiencies
- Manitoowoc Heating is here today (2-3-25) finishing up repairs on the gym air handler, stayed tuned for final cost on that repair, estimated at a couple thousand dollars
- We have begun work on the old trainer's room to turn it into a "green room" for the drama club to use for costume changes, makeup, etc. (This is being funded from the Fine Arts budget)
- Christmas break went quickly but was productive
- Painted the commons stairwell and upgraded lights to LED (I'll submit an incentive app in the near future)
- Setup the new press box (hung 3 TVs, new camera mount) and completed all the "small " things with the new gym
- Lots of little odds & ends that we can't normally get done in some rooms during normal school days (toilet/urinal issues, classroom lights, etc)
- Had two of the vans serviced (oil changes & tire rotations)
- Helped haul concert equipment to the Capital Civic Centre for the Christmas Concert.
- Marty and Jonah were able to get into more areas for a more thorough cleaning. Marty buffed all the hallways
- Marty emptied and cleaned some janitor's closets
- Jonah shampooed some high traffic area carpets
- The Master Site Plan Committee had their first meeting to start brainstorming ideas for the future of our campus. Initial thoughts are, due to the increasing enrollment, to start heading down the path of additional classrooms, a move of the offices to facilitate that, and also moving the kitchen to the main floor. These are a couple of the many priorities the committee is going to start investigating.
