Our nationally recognized robotics team gives our students opportunities in design, programming, computer science, marketing, and competition.





Manitowoc Lutheran student population has seen steady growth of enrollment over the last six years. Total enrollment for 2024-25 is 277. The MLHS enrollment is projected to be 302 for the 2025-26 school year, topping the 300 soul mark for the first time in 20 years, praise God!



Students at MLHS scored the same or higher than 96.4% of all 9-12 schools tested in the state of Wisconsin in the priority areas of English Language Arts and Mathematics. In English Language Arts, MLHS outperformed the state average by 25%. In Mathematics, MLHS students were over 27% higher than the state average.
