A Week to Change a Lifetime

This upcoming June, Badger Boys State will be holding its first session since 2019. We are excited to welcome nearly 900 young leaders from across Wisconsin to the UW-Eau Claire campus and are working diligently to plan an impactful session.

Upon arriving at the 2022 session of Badger Boys State, participants will become citizens of one of 27 cities and one of 9 counties within Badger Boys State. Citizens are tasked with electing public officials at the city, county, and state levels and governing effectively throughout the session.

Through this process, young leaders not only learn the fundamentals of civics, but also develop the interpersonal skills and confidence necessary for the next generation of leaders to feel empowered to be leaders in their local communities. The next generation of leaders, just like any before them, have immense societal challenges to address, and our staff takes seriously our responsibility in helping young leaders develop the education and skills needed to make a positive impact.



All staff members of Badger Boys State serve on a volunteer basis. Our staff consists of leaders of many professions and from across the United States. Staff members take time away from their friends and families and time off from work to support the program and its mission each year.

Timeline

October 15, 2021

Sponsorship Cards are made available.

January 1, 2022

If possible, please submit the Sponsorship Card by January 1, 2022. This allows our administrative staff time to send registration information to school counselors by January 15, 2022.

Sponsors are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. It is important to note that the earlier we receive a Sponsorship Card, the more easily we will be able to match each sponsor with a young leader from Wisconsin.

March 15, 2022

Young leaders who have been selected by their local community educators are asked to register by March 15, 2022. By this point in time, we hope to have matched all interested young leaders with sponsors.

We may have alternate students who will only be provided the opportunity to attend if we can secure more sponsorships. We aim to offer all interested young leaders the opportunity to participate in Badger Boys State, but this is only possible with the generous support of sponsors.

April-June, 2022

Leading up to the Badger Boys State session, young leaders will be asked to attend an online orientation, where they will learn more about the program from our staff and have an opportunity to ask any questions they have.

June 12, 2022

Young leaders will arrive at Badger Boys State ready to participate and excited for the week.

Eligibility

Any Wisconsin student who will complete their junior year of high school by June 12, 2022 will be eligible to attend Badger Boys State.

For the 2022 session, any student who will complete their senior year by the start of the session will also be eligible to attend, due to the cancellation of the 2021 session. While seniors will not be eligible to attend Boys Nation or earn the Samsung Scholarship, their participation in the program is otherwise identical to junior students.

We encourage students of all backgrounds, identities, and socioeconomic status to attend Badger Boys State. Our selection process prioritizes fairness and equal opportunity. We strive to convene a group of participants that is representative of the state of Wisconsin.

Badger Boys State does not discriminate on the basis of age, race, disability, sexual orientation, national origin, handicap, creed, color, political affiliation, ancestry, or membership in the National Guard, state defense force, or any other reserve component of the military forces of the United States or Wisconsin.

School leaders, such as administrators, counselors, and teachers, should select students who have demonstrated leadership potential. Scholarship is important, but not paramount. A potential leader is not necessarily the best scholar. Students with varied backgrounds, identities, socioeconomic status, and academic performance have been successful citizens of Badger Boys State. Many students can thrive in our program, and our staff is committed to supporting every student. Every student will be an integral part of Badger Boys State.
