PLEASE SIGN UP FOR AUDITION TIMES IN THE MUSIC CENTER HALLWAY.

Please bring your audition form to the tryout filled out completely.

Audition Process:

Step 1: Sign up for auditions in the Music Center hallway.

When are auditions?

- Individual auditions will be held Tuesday and Wednesday, May 27th & 28th.
- We will have group auditions at 2:45pm on Thursday May 29th after 8th hour exams.
- It is a two-day audition.

Step 2: Fill out the “Lancer Singer Audition Form” and submit.

- Make sure to fill out all of the information that is asked.
- Hand the completed form to Mr. Ungemach at your audition

Step 3: Audition with Mr. Ungemach in the Choir Room at your audition time:

During your **individual audition in the Choir Room on Monday or Tuesday you will:**

- Discuss your audition form
- Discuss Lancer Singers
- Be tested for your vocal range (how high or low you can sing)
- Sing the Melody and the appropriate harmony line of LAPPY 264 “Seek Ye First”
- Sing your part in “Jesu Priceless Treasure”
- Tap out two rhythm patterns
- Sing three sight singing lines

During your **group audition in the Choir Room on Wednesday you will:**

- Be responsible for your part in “Seek Ye First” & “Jesu Priceless Treasure”
- Sing as an assigned group, 4 to 8 at a time. Work on blend and holding your own part.
- Everybody should attend!

I realize that there may be conflicts due to sports practices, please plan to audition at times that do not conflict or talk to your coaches.

Lancer Singer Q & A:

What are things that I consider as I decide who will be in Lancer Singers next year?

- Christian attitude and behavior
- Musical Ability
 - My intentions are to pick the best sounding choir, not necessarily the best individual singers.
 - Your ability to blend and work together with each other is a strong consideration.
- Dedication as presented in classwork and other extra-curricular activities.
- Dependability
- Academic Status

What are the expectations for a Lancer Singer?

- Per school policy, Lancer Singers must be a confirmed member of a WELS congregation or a congregation/ministry in fellowship with the WELS.
- Lancer Singers must be a member of Concert Choir in the academic school day.
- Positive attitude towards other Lancer Singers and the director
- Set an example at home, school, and in the congregations that we visit
- Attend **ALL** rehearsals and performances and **BE ON TIME**
 - School work and LS need to come before an outside job. I will give a schedule of practices and events long in advance so that you can work around practices with your employer. We are a team that has everyone in the game at the same time. **When one person is gone, the whole team is handicapped!**
- Keep up with daily studies and perform up to ability for your grades
- Participate positively in practice
- Communicate with the director when you have a concern or question
- ***Please be aware that there is a financial commitment that goes along with being chosen for LS. Each student is asked to pay a fee for outfits, shoes, and accessories.***

Audition Helpful Hints

Here are some helpful hints for the audition:

- Practice with the online recordings on the MLHS website!
- Singing is a visual art. Your facial expressions and emotion when singing are what will set you apart from the rest. Interpret the song in your performance! The meaning of the text should show in your eyes as you perform!
- Diction is very important when you sing. Please over-emphasize your diction during your tryout. I should be able to read your lips! Sing into a mirror and check yourself!
- **You will probably be nervous**, recognize that and rise above it. A little nervousness is good but try not to let it affect your tryout.
- Smile and enjoy yourself. Singing is supposed to be fun!!
