This gift will do far more than refresh brick and paint. It will:

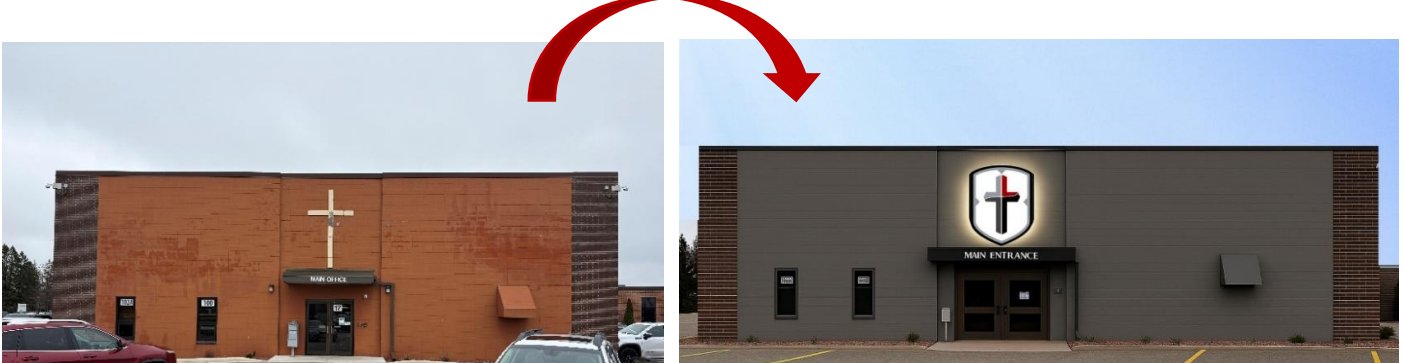
- Greatly enhance the **beauty and curb appeal** of the school
