Freshmen Information Nights

- 80 prospective eighth grade students attended the recent Freshmen Information Nights. This represents 100% of the students that Mr. Holper expected to enroll next year.
- 65 prospective students have turned in a course selection sheet to Mr. Holper. He will follow up with the remaining 15 students over the next two months.
- These numbers do not count prospective students from the public schools, international students, or transfers.
- Mr. Holper received many positive comments about the new format and we plan to keep it the same next year.

Lancer for a Day

- Mr. Holper hosted 215 seventh and eighth graders in January during Lancer for a Day.
- 230 students were expected to attend but St. John's Two Rivers was unable to participate.

Grade School Basketball

- Mr. Holper visited each grade school in January to conduct the Hot Shot competition.
- Grade school basketball teams are benefiting from having more courts available for their tournaments.

Outreach to St. Peter's Sturgeon Bay

- We met with parents, students and staff at St. Peter's in December to discuss the increasing interest in sending students to MLHS.
- The biggest challenge is offering transportation to and from school each day. We are exploring options that
 include finding volunteer drivers based in Door County and the feasibility of adding another van route. We are
 also looking into finding host families in Manitowoc.
